


Multi-state Information Sharing Initiative



Problem Statement:


- Reliably and securely perform a fully automated, electronic cross-state check on suspicious activity reports (SARs) without compromising individual states' data

Technical Approach:

- Web services separate state specific implementations from commonly agreed interfaces for SARs exchange
- Leverages existing communication/security protocols and networks as well as the simplest and the most available internet technologies
- Simple, Google-like search interface

Benefit:

- Allows analysts from different states to follow leads and perform trend analysis across state boundaries
- Minimizes technical, administrative, and maintenance burden on the states
